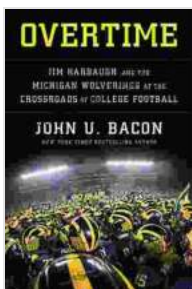


# Jim Harbaugh and the Michigan Wolverines: At the Crossroads of College Football

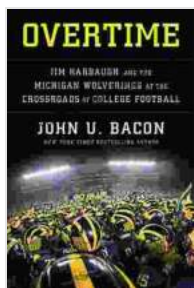
