

The Olympic Games and the football World Cup have shown that why more and more sports events are the stars of this so-called "globalization". Most frequently megaparades, the result of the public effort by main organizing bodies or countries, of course stamping their predecessor in grandeur and anything else concerning the event in question! But needless to say, there is much more than simple competition between systems. Large-scale sports events – and not only the largest – have significant impact for the organizers, both in the long and the short term, even though they last only for a week or two. In addition, the largest events are enormously expensive to organize, but in return bring global media exposure with effects and a value that cannot be achieved in any other way.

Professor Holger Preuss is one of the few sport scientists, who focus on the organization around larger sports events rather than on different aspects of the practicing of sports or the competition itself. What are the deliberations behind the decision to bid for a large sports event? What should the revenue be in order to legitimate substantial (public) investments when resources are scarce and social and other needs acute? The title of Professor Preuss's article holds the answer: Investments in a sports event has to bring positive effects for the citizenry/population, effects that last longer than the event itself. Such effects can, among other things, be short-term financial profit re-invested for long-term benefits; investments in infrastructure that last long after the competitions and contribute to enhancement of local productivity; effects on well-being for the city/country as a business destination, notably for sports tourism. Holger Preuss explains how these positive effects are achieved – while the negative consequences – in his well-written and solidly argued article, which also offers substantiated empirical literature on these issues.




